SERVICE PROVIDER REPORTS

Executive Director/Administrator: In addition to the report submitted, Mr. Raymond L. Hughes II welcomed questions and/or comments from those in attendance.

Ms. Maryjane Hydro stated that 2022 Auto ID Cards, 2022 Workers' Compensation Posting Notices and 2022 Safety Calendars are currently being distributed to Fund Members. Furthermore, the timeline for the SCJIF Fair and Open process for soliciting 2022 Fund Year Request For Proposals for Professional Services was provided. The Request For Proposals were posted on November 18, 2021 in *The Courier News, The Hunterdon Democrat* and on the Fund's website. Responses are due on Thursday, December 2, 2021.

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 health concerns, Fund Members received two versions of the proposed 2022 Meeting Calendar for consideration prior to adoption. Historical tradition has been to hold the December SCJIF Commissioner's meeting on Wednesday, December 15th, 2021 at the Somerville B.P.O. Elks Lodge #1068.

Fund Attorney - Claims Management / Litigation: No additions to the report submitted.

Fund Attorney – Regulatory Compliance / Legislation: In addition to the report submitted, Fund Attorney Berry advised all Fund Members that thirty days have passed without communication from the NJ Department of Banking & Insurance in regard to the Fund's Return of Surplus. Therefore, it is deemed approved, and distribution of the dividends may take place at the Fund's December Meeting.

Attorney Berry also elaborated and provided a detailed explanation on the caselaw and changes to Legislation discussed in her Report. Questions were raised.

Third Party Administrator: No additions to the report submitted, however, Mr. Javier Esparra welcomed questions from participants.

Custodian of Funds: No additions to the report submitted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Safety Committee: On behalf of Committee Chairperson Sipple, Ms. Maryjane Hydro, NJRM, advised that the Safety Committee met in October via Zoom Video Conference and met in-person in November at the Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools/TradeWins Restaurant. The Meeting Minutes were included in the package. Ms. Maryjane Hydro expressed that meeting "In-Person" adds value in fostering the safety culture within the Committee as it allows for Representatives to communicate and exchange ideas in a manner that has not been possible during Zoom calls. However, the Fund values opinions expressed by Safety Committee Members. To that end, a Survey was distributed inquiring a preference for future meetings "in-person" or via Zoom Videoconferencing. The results of the Survey will be shared with Committee Members.

Ms. Hydro also advised that two "Chainsaw Safety Trainings" took place on October 7th at the Township of Raritan, and October 26th at the NJ Crane Experts of Flemington facilities. Approximately 30 participants were in attendance at each program. These extremely popular and often requested Training seminars were available thanks to a Risk Management Grant from the SCJIF Reinsurance Carrier, MunichRe.

Furthermore, Safety Committee Members were also reminded to submit documentation for credit toward the 2021 Safety Incentive Program which will be concluding at the end of December. Safety Committee Representatives were reminded that Members have access to On-Line Safety Training which is an extremely valuable tool to achieve their Entities' individual training goals. Since the inception of this program, approximately 2,300 on-line safety training courses have been completed, with 230 courses completed in 2021 thus far. Currently, there are approximately 300 training topics available to all SCJIF employees in the expansive library. A brief demonstration on how to sign-up and access the training was presented during the Meeting to those in attendance.

The next scheduled Safety Committee Meeting will be held in-person on Tuesday, December 7th, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. at the TradeWins Restaurant of the Somerset County Vocational & Technical Schools. A teleconference option will also be available.

Claim PAR Committee: In addition to the reports submitted, Committee Chairperson Soriano advised that the results of the Claim PAR Committee Telephonic Meetings held on October 27th and November 15th, 2021 will be ratified during the Old Business portion of the Agenda.
